 I Matthew Slater of Vine Street Golden Square in
 the parish of Saint James Westminster in the County of
 Middlesex Gentelman do make and publish this my last
 will and Testament in manner and form following - -
 I give all my just debts to be paid and satisfied and that
 my Body may be decently and privately buried at - -
 the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named give - -
 devise and bequeath all my real and personal Estate - -
 of whatsoever nature kind or quality the same may be
 and wheresoever situate and whith I now am or shall
 or may at the time of my decease be possessed of interested
 in or intitled unto to my dearly beloved wife Elizabeth
 Slater her heirs Executors administrators and assigns for
 ever subject to the following Legacies viz. the sum of ten
 pounds each to my Brothers and Sisters for mourning
 and make grave and appoint my said wife Elizabeth
 Slater sole Executrix of this my will hereby revoking all
 other wills by me at any time heretofore made in - - -
 witness whereof I have to this my last will and Testament
 contained in one sheet of paper out my hand and seal - - -
 this seventh day of September in the year of our Lord
 One thousand seven hundred and ninety eight Matt^r
 Slater (S^r) signed sealed published and declared by the
 said Testator Matthew Slater as and for his last will - -
 and Testament in the presence of us who in his presence
 and that of each other have severally subscribed our
 names as witnesses thereto William Lewis, Rich^d Kedd
 Great Queen Street. -

This Will was proved at London the
 fourteenth day of June in the year of our Lord One
 thousand eight hundred and four before the worshipful
 Samuel Prave parson Doctor of Laws and Surrogate
 of the Right Honorable Sir William Wynne Knight also
 Doctor of Laws Master Scribe or Commissary of the
 prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted
 by the oath of Elizabeth Slater widow the executrix and
 the sole Executrix named in the said will to whom
 a donation of all and singular the Goods Chattels and
 Credits of the said deceased was granted having been
 first sworn duly to administer. -
